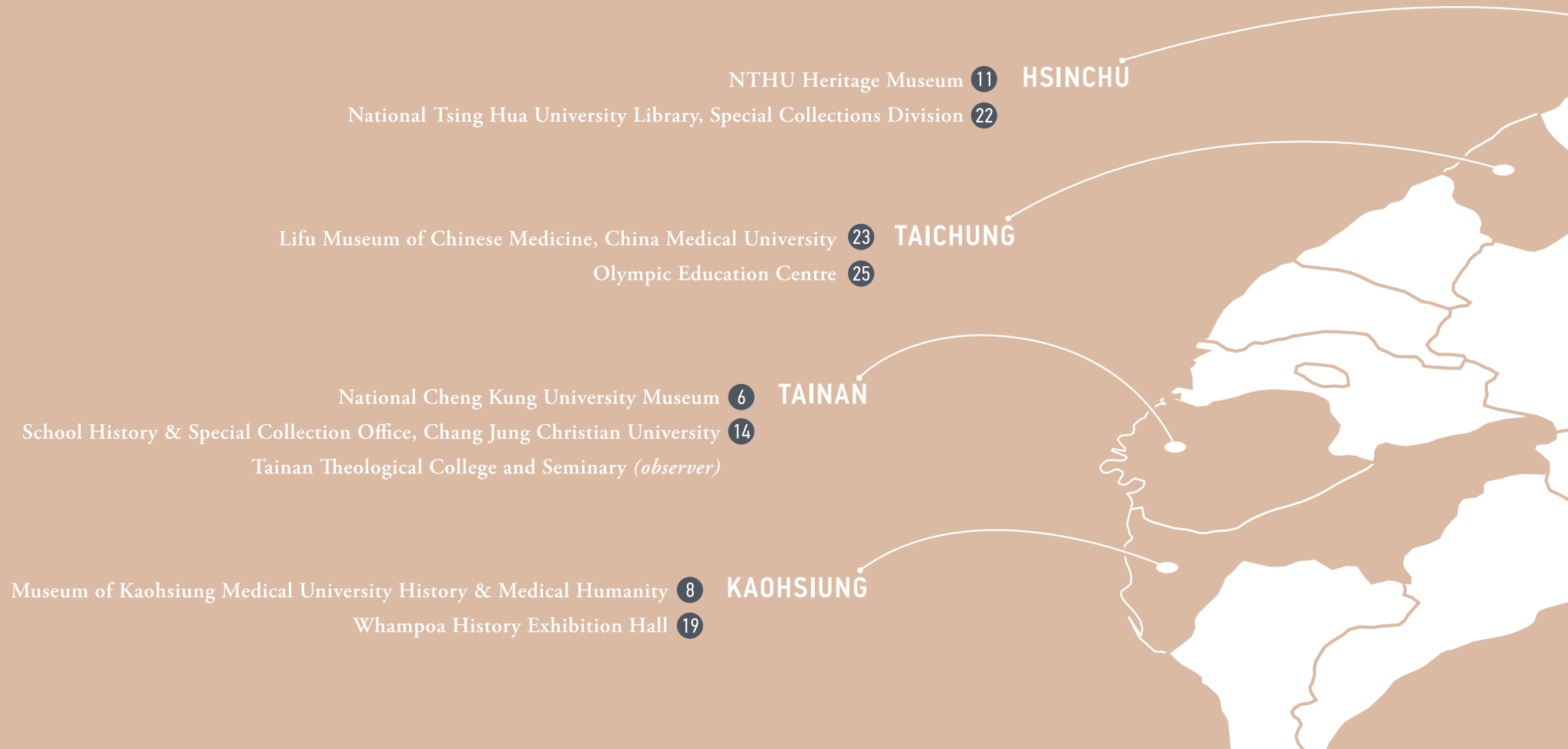

National Cheng Kung University was established in 1931. The NCKU Museum was initiated in 1999 and officially established in 2007 in the old administration building. It is the first museum established under a public university structure in Taiwan. The whole campus is considered as an eco-museum, consisting of the main museum, the campus environment museum, and departmental professional museums or historical galleries. The main museum is in charge of the collection, research, exhibition, and educational promotion of the cultural heritages and the eco-museum within the entire university. It also supports the establishment and activities of college or department-level museums or historical galleries.

National Taiwan University has accumulated a tremendous wealth of specimens, literatures, and cultural artifacts for near a century since its founding in 1928. These collections, among the finest and most comprehensive in Taiwan, are housed in various departments on campus and have been used for both research and education. The NTU Museums currently include the NTU History Gallery, the Museum of Anthropology, the Geo-specimen Cottage, the Heritage Hall of Physics, the Insect Museum, the Agricultural Exhibition Hall, the Herbarium, the Museum of Zoology, the Archives, the Museum of Medical Humanities and the Art Museum Preparatory Office, together with the TAIDA Museum Provisional Office commencing in 2019.

The Kaohsiung Medical University inherits the legacy of the first western-style hospital established in Kaohsiung in the late 19th Century, which began the history of modern medical services in Taiwan. Established in October 2014, the museum is open to all faculty, students, and citizens and aims to collect and exhibit the related archives and medical instruments to advocate medical humanity. Visitors of the museum would realize the growth of the university and the medical development of southern Taiwan.

The Museum of Ethnology of NCCU is officially opened to public in 2000. The majority of its collection is from Taiwan Indigenous Peoples. The most important character of the Museum of Ethnology is that its position has been decided as a “teaching museum” at the time when it was established. So the museum is operated and managed by teachers and students, and all the exhibitions are also designed and completed by students under the guidance of teachers.

Taihoku Higher School, the predecessor of National Taiwan Normal University, was established in 1922. NTNU Archives are located on the 1st and 8th floors of the main library. The physical and cultural relics include the medal of the fourth President of Taihoku Higher School, Tanimoto Kiyomune, and the painting fan of the famous Japanese artist Shiotsuki Touho. The artistic, technological, and accessible design of the exhibition and a variety of precious artifacts show NTNU's long history of development.

The NTHU Heritage Museum located on the first floor of the Main Library and holds several special exhibitions every year. These exhibitions are free and open to the public. The exhibitions focus on the paintings and calligraphy collection among the NTHU curation in relation to the modern Confucianism in the eastern Asia, as well as folk culture and personal documents from the Ming dynasty in the 14th century, Qing dynasty, Edo period, to the Japanese colonial period in Taiwan till 1949 when the ROC government relocated its capital from Nanjing to Taipei, spanning over 300 years. The value of these historical materials is inestimable.

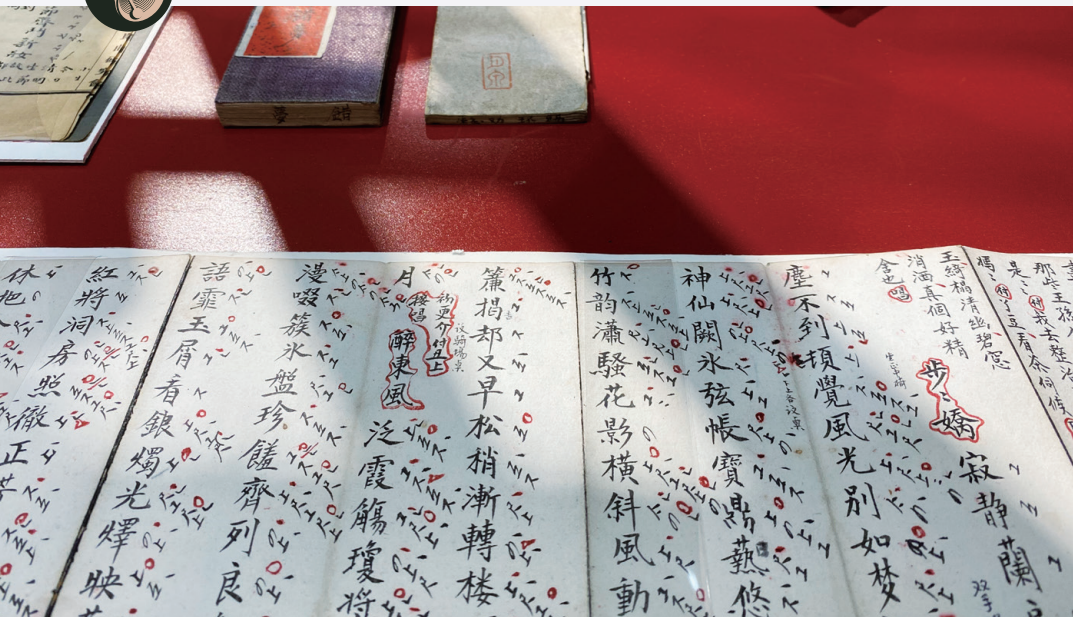

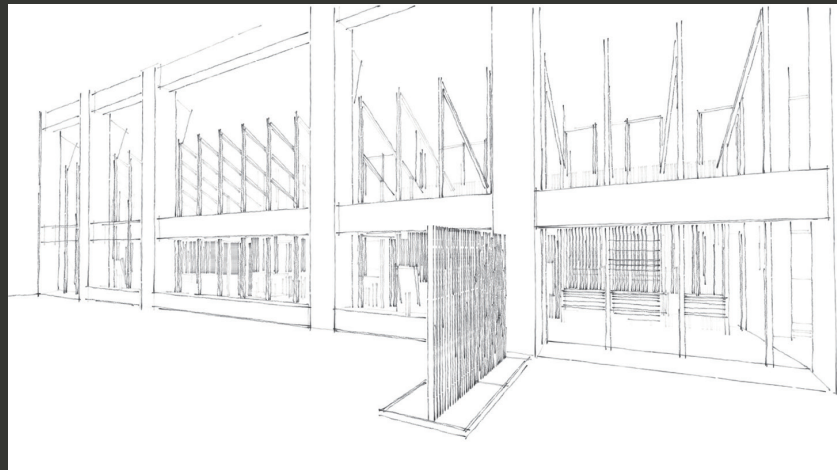

The classic collection includes: over 20 sets of costumes, over 20 pieces of calligraphy and painting, over 300 hand copied, and over 100 pieces of other relics. The establishment of Kunqu Opera Museum in National Central University in November 2017 is a result of years of planning for the purpose of displaying and collecting opera relics. Kunqu Opera Museum will function as a base for the popularization and research of opera arts and art education in Taiwan.

On March 9th, 1872, Reverend Dr. George Leslie Mackay of the Presbyterian Church in Canada, crossed the seas and arrived in Tamsui. On July 21st, 1882, the building was completed, and was named in commemoration of his fellow countrymen who generously contributed to it: OXFORD COLLEGE. OXFORD COLLEGE has been the cradle of Taiwan Seminary, Tamsui High School, and Aletheia University College for over a hundred years. This is the earliest modern educational institution in northern Taiwan. It is currently used as a museum and nation designated historic site.

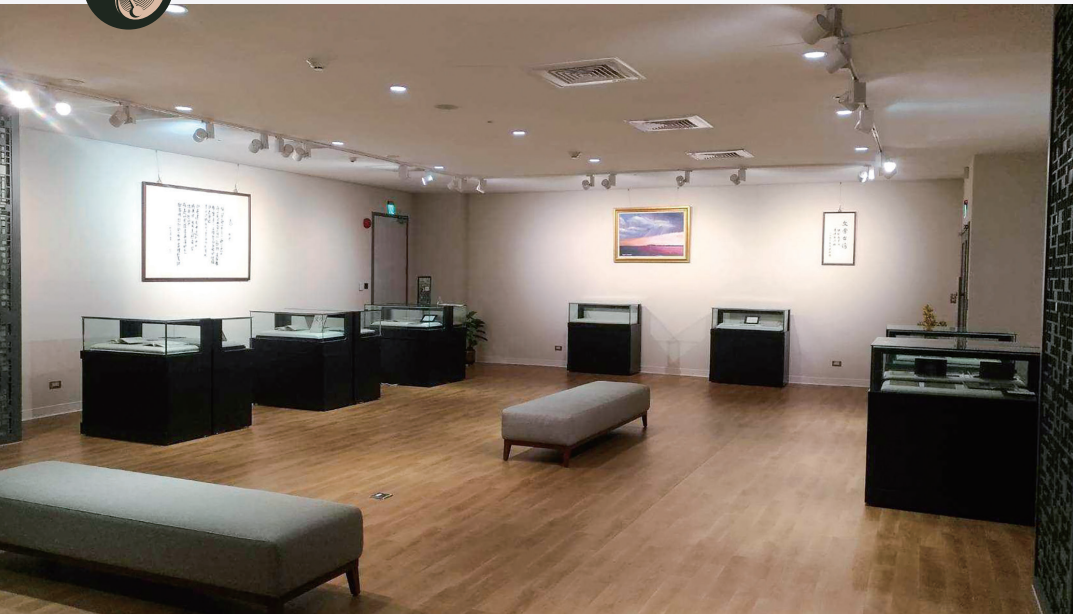
